North Carolina Society of Radiologic Technologists, Inc. Bylaws

<i>Proposed</i>	<i>Rationale</i>
<p>Article IV – MEMBERSHIP <u>Section 3 – Voting Members</u> A. Active: Active members shall be those individuals who are registered with the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) or its equivalent or hold an unrestricted license under state statutes and who are employed in the medical imaging or radiation therapy profession. They shall have all rights, privileges and obligations of membership including the right to vote, debate, and hold office. Replace with: <u>registered or certified in a primary modality by certification agencies recognized by the ASRT</u></p>	<p>Editorial; to be consistent with ASRT Bylaws.</p>
<p>Article IV – MEMBERSHIP <u>Section 3 – Voting Members</u> B. Inactive: Inactive members shall be those individuals who are registered with the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) or its equivalent or hold an unrestricted license under state statutes and who are not employed in the medical imaging or radiation therapy profession. These members shall have all rights, privileges and obligations of active members including the right to vote and debate; however, they shall not hold office. Replace with: <u>registered or certified in a primary modality by certification agencies recognized by the ASRT</u></p>	<p>Editorial; to be consistent with ASRT Bylaws.</p>
<p>Article IV – MEMBERSHIP <u>Section 4 – Non-Voting Members</u> D. Supporting: Supporting members shall be those individuals who demonstrate an interest in the medical imaging or radiation therapy profession; but do not qualify for any other established status. These members shall have all rights, privileges and obligations of active members including the right to debate, however, they shall not vote or hold office. Replace: period after “profession” to a <u>comma</u>.</p>	<p>Grammatical edit.</p>

<p>Article IV – MEMBERSHIP <u>Section 5 – Application Fees</u></p> <p>The application fee for members shall be uniform and of such amount as is required by the Society and determined by a majority vote of the Board of Directors. Members shall be given at least thirty (30) day²s notice prior to the vote of any proposed change. Replace: strike the apostrophe in day’s to become <u>days</u></p>	Grammatical edit.
<p>ARTICLE IX- Electronic Meetings and Communication</p> <p>Section 1. Meetings The Board of Directors and all committees and subcommittees shall be authorized to meet by telephone conference or through other electronic communications media so long as all the members may simultaneously hear each other and participate during the meeting.</p> <p>Section 2. Communication All communication required in these bylaws, including meeting notices, may be sent electronically.</p>	Insertion of a new article. To be consistent with current practice and ASRT Bylaws.
<p>Article IX- Censure, Reprimand and Removal becomes Article X. Article X-Society Delegates to the ASRT House of Delegates becomes Article XI. Article XI-Affiliate Charter Agreement becomes Article XII. Article XII-Parliamentary Authority becomes Article XIII. Article XIII-Amendments becomes Article XIV. Article XIV-Indemnification becomes Article XV. Article XV-Dissolution becomes Article XVI.</p>	Re-number sections if a new section is created for Electronic Meetings and Communication.
