

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

North Carolina Society of Radiologic Technologists

A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

We, the undersigned natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators for the purpose of creating a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of North Carolina, as contained in Chapter 55A of the General Statutes of North Carolina, entitled "Non-Profit Corporation Act", and the several amendments thereto, do hereby set forth:

1. The name of the corporation is North Carolina Society of Radiologic Technologists

2. The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual

(May be perpetual or for a limited period)

3. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

a. To advance the science of radiologic technology.

b. To assist in establishing and maintaining high standards of education and training in the field of radiologic technology.

c. To elevate the quality of patient care in the field of radiologic technology.

d. To engage in any other lawful activity including but not limited to, improving the welfare and socio-economics of radiologic technologists.

4. The corporation is to have the following class or classes of members: (If there are to be no members, so state.)
